Good and Green Initiatives at the AJM Group for 2017 - 2018

- Touch screen system for reduction of label size for Good and Green with an estimated savings of 30% in paper consumption
- Working with GCPL associates to reduce rejection rate incidents
- Working on metrics for direct online supplies for GCPL factories
- Studying new production methods for wick manufacturing to reduce time to customer
Introduction of new pin bridge tool based on SPC principles at Samvi
- Introduction of new wave soldering machine for PCB production with increased capacity at Samvi which is fully RoHS compliant
- Explored FR4 PCB (versus FR2 PCB) for reduction in fire hazard congruent to Godrej Good and Green initiative
